SAFETY TIPS

- Are there fire extinguishers in the halls?
- Are there fire extinguishers inside the units?



Look at the number of exits - do you have a fire escape plan (2 ways out of every room).



Make sure there are smoke detectors. Test all smoke alarms atleast monthly. Never disable the alarm.



- Make sure there are carbon monoxide detectors.
- ► Is the building equipped with sprinklers?
- Check your school's rules before using electrical appliances in your room.
 - ► Buy flameless candles.
